Abstract

- Abstracts must not exceed 300 words in length, excluding title, names and affiliation. The first name of authors, not just initials, should be given.
- Abstracts must contain a clear statement of the purpose of the work, the methods used, the results, and conclusions. It is acceptable to present preliminary results.
- Please format using Times New Roman font size 12 with no subheadings
- Authors must provide a statement confirming that the work described in the abstract conforms with regional laws regulating the use of animals in research
