### **Rules**

Categories include;

- **ARTISTIC**
- **ANIMALS IN THE WILD**
- **ZOO AND AQUARIUM ANIMALS**

Competition opens **27<sup>th</sup> January 2018** and all photos must be submitted by **4<sup>TH</sup> March 2018**. Entries are strictly limited to three (3) per individual. Please submit all entries to [Caroline.Monro@merlinentertainments.biz](mailto:Caroline.Monro@merlinentertainments.biz) ensuring the following information is included:

- **Your name, institution and/or address**
- **Title/caption of the photograph**
- **Which category best suits the submitted photograph**
- **Cite 'ASZK Photo Comp' in the subject line.**

All photos must be in **JPEG format (Max. size is 30MB)** and must be accompanied with a **signed Photo Release Form** (Release Forms can be found on the ASZK website).

### **Judging and Prizes**

The ASZK steering committee will select their two (2) favourite photos from each category to display at the ASZK Annual Conference, May 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> at Moonlit Sanctuary Wildlife Conservation Park, Victoria.

Conference delegates will then have an opportunity to vote for their favourites! The photograph receiving the most votes from each category will subsequently be displayed on the front cover of *Thylacinus* - the quarterly journal of the society.

The photograph receiving the most votes overall will earn its photographer an honorary ASZK membership for 12 months!
