Kyabram Fauna Park encompasses 55 hectares of open woodland and wetlands and is home to more than 600 native Australian animals including koalas, dingoes, macropods, wombats, echidna, emus, flying-foxes and quolls. Native reptiles such as snakes, crocodile, lizards and turtles and with our invertebrate exhibition including spiders, scorpions and stick insects. The park is nestled in the picturesque Victorian countryside just half an hour from the popular tourist destination of Echuca and within an hour's drive to Bendigo.

Kyabram Fauna Park require an experienced, friendly and committed Wildlife Keeper to work with our various species of native fauna, the applicant will also require herpetology experience with a focus on venomous snake handling. The position is a Permanent Part time position with a guaranteed 22.5 hours per week with the potential to gain further hours.

- High level of communication and interpersonal skills with external stakeholders, peers, staff, volunteers and public with the ability to deliver public presentations and conduct visitor experiences.
- Demonstrated knowledge of Occupational Health and Safety practices.
- Basic horticulture and maintenance skills.
- Experience with various species of native fauna covering all animal classes we have here at the park including Mammals, Birds, Reptiles, Amphibians, Fish and Invertebrates.

- Working with Children and National Police Check
