Kyabram Fauna Park encompasses 55 hectares of open woodland and wetlands and is home to more than 600 native Australian animals including koalas, dingoes, macropods, wombats, echidna, emus, flying-foxes and quolls. Native reptiles such as snakes, crocodile, lizards and turtles and with our invertebrate exhibition including spiders, scorpions and stick insects. The park is nestled in the picturesque Victorian countryside just half an hour from the popular tourist destination of Echuca and within an hour's drive to Bendigo.
