Dreamworld Corroboree is one of the largest native wildlife parks in South East Queensland with hundreds of native animals including the second largest koala population in the world.

The primary responsibility of this role is to provide the highest standard of animal care for our captive animal collection, and maintain the enclosures and exhibits. Tasks include feeding, cleaning, record keeping, animal enrichment and guest interaction to educate the public and share your knowledge of animals, habitats & behaviours. Additionally, the successful applicant will assist the Veterinary Clinic with a range of duties and maintain clinical records.

This is a physically demanding role that involves animal husbandry tasks and manual handling, therefore the ability to perform physically demanding work is essential. Sound written and verbal communication skills are essential as interaction with a diverse range of people from differing cultures is involved, and report writing and record keeping is a requirement of the role.

The ideal candidate will have a thorough knowledge and extensive experience working with Australian native fauna. The successful applicant must have a Certificate IV Veterinary Nursing, with additional certificates in zoo keeping being highly desirable.

Flexibility with working hours across a 7 day roster is essential, and weekend work will be involved. A current manual drivers license is also required.
