- Previous hands-on experience working with Australian wildlife
- Demonstrate well developed communication, teamwork and customer service skills
- Possess a high level of physical fitness to perform physically demanding work

Animal husbandry qualifications and/or progressive study towards a zoo keeping certificate would be well regarded. Experience with animal husbandry and handling coupled with a good general knowledge of Australian native fauna is required. A current manual driver's license is also necessary.

Flexibility with working hours across a 7 day roster is essential as weekend work will be involved. Part-time (PT20) employment offers a minimum of 20 hours per week and will accrue leave entitlements on a pro-rata basis.

This is a physically demanding role that involves animal husbandry tasks and manual handling, therefore a high level of energy and physical fitness is required to perform manual handling tasks and physically demanding work.
