We are currently seeking an experienced keeper to work mainly with our native collection. Working as part of a small, friendly team you will have genuine opportunities to implement new ideas to the zoo, contribute to breeding programmes and make a difference. The species within this include Dingos, Devils, various species of wallabies, Quolls, Emus, Wombats, Bilbies, Kangaroos and more. Experience is advantageous. Immediate start desirable.

Duties of the position will include:

- Daily food preparation, presentation, and husbandry for a variety of species.
- Animal observation and record keeping.
- Involvement in breeding, behavioural enrichment, and conditioning programs.
- Assistance in animal capture and veterinary procedures.
- Public animal encounters.

Desirable skills and attributes:

- Zoo-keeping experience or Certificate III in Zoo Keeping, Animal Management (Captive Wild Animals) or equivalent would be advantageous as role flexibility is valued.
- Proactive in identifying husbandry and enclosure related issues.
- Experience in training and conditioning.
