

Avian Coordinator

There is also opportunity to work closely with the Avian Threatened Species Coordinator to promote breeding capacity for our various avian threatened species.

Essential Criteria:

- Certificate III in Captive Animals or equivalent
- Understanding of the 5 domains model of animal welfare
- Ability to perform health related checks for various avian species
- Ability to monitor breeding milestones for various avian species
- Develop and implement training and conditioning programs
- Develop and implement animal enrichment programs
- Strong written and verbal communication skills, preferably being proficient in the use of Zoological Information Management System (ZIMS)
- Computer literate Microsoft office / electronic checklists and collaboration software
- Demonstrate an understanding of the importance of hygiene and biosecurity
- Confident at delivering keeper talks to the public
- Applicants must be fit for physical work, enthusiastic, well-presented and able to demonstrate a high level of work ethic and initiative
- Full-time with weekend work, including public holidays and school holidays
- Hold a current car licence
