Guest interaction sessions and internal presentations with the tigers are also an integral part of this role to provide educational information about the cats and global conservation of the species. This role will also additionally support our Wildlife team by providing husbandry duties for our native animal collection.

To be considered, applicants must have:

- A solid background of industry experience working with native, exotic or non-domestic animals, ideally with tertiary qualifications in zoological sciences;
- Extensive animal husbandry experience
- A friendly, outgoing personality with excellent communication skills and the ability to engage confidently and professionally with guests
- Commitment to teamwork, safety, and animal welfare
- A high level of physical dexterity with the ability to safely perform physically demanding work tasks
- Be vaccinated against Q-Fever
- A current driver's licence
- Background in animal training and behavioural enrichment is desirable

Flexibility with working hours is essential and weekend work will be involved.
