Experience with animal husbandry and handling coupled with a good general knowledge of Australian native fauna is required. A current manual driver's license is also necessary.

Flexibility with working hours across a 7-day roster is essential as weekend work will be involved.

This is a physically demanding role that involves animal husbandry tasks and manual handling; therefore, a high level of energy and physical fitness is required to perform manual handling tasks and physically demanding work.
