An opportunity has arisen for a motivated individual to join our committed and friendly team. Initially you will be trained on our Front of House sections, (Admissions and Food and Beverage) and our Animal Kitchen (Animal Food Preparation).

Once you have shown competency in these areas, we will start your training on one of our keeping rounds, including animal encounters, which will be alternated with the previously described roles.

Duties of the position will include:

- Selling tickets and upselling encounters.
- Working in our Food van.
- Daily food preparation for a variety of species.
- Animal husbandry/ Keeping.
- Public animal encounters.

- Proactive and professional in all that you do
- Willing to be flexible on the rostered rounds and through the day to assist the team as required across a variety of duties.
- Good customer service skills.
- Mature team player with proof of a positive attitude with visitors and driven to connect our visitors with our wildlife.
- High level of physical fitness for a physically demanding job. We are a small team with a busy workload that is divided into standard round routines, we are looking for an individual who is capable for the physical aspects of animal keeping.
- Current Working with Children's Check and First Aid Certificate or ability to obtain.

- Certificate III in Zoo Keeping, Animal Management (Captive Wild Animals) or equivalent would be advantageous.
- Experience working or volunteering in a zoological facility or with domestic animals.
- Previous customer service experience.
